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Coming Soon: The Salty Pig, More Summer Shack



Pork-mania is alive and well in Boston. Many menus at casual eateries offer the option to hold a pig roast for large parties, and now a forthcoming Back Bay resto will honor the animal with its name as well as its menu. **The Salty Pig**, a casual American featuring the likes of bacon, charcuterie and so forth, is slated to open in the former Six Burner space, across from the Back Bay MBTA station, on June 16. There will be a large bar of reclaimed wood, patio seating and a drinks menu big on craft beers, while the menu will be rounded out by assorted cheeses, flatbread pizzas,

sandwiches, salads and entrees. It's owned and operated by the same folks who run [Coda](#) and [Canary Square](#) (130 Dartmouth St.).

A few days later on June 21, the first day of summer, **Jasper White** is set to open his fifth [Summer Shack](#). The new Dedham branch will feature the usual family-friendly casual setting and holding tank for lobsters (you get to pick your own for dinner), and there will also be a large bar/lounge area with TVs, a raw bar and more (850 Providence Highway).

Speaking of Summer Shack, the seafooder has set up snack shacks on Georges and Spectacle Islands, which are part of the Boston Harbor Islands – great destinations for warm-season outings.
